New service for Ultimo and Pyrmont

We are pleased to announce a new weekly shuttle bus service for the residents of Ultimo and Pyrmont.

This service has been prompted by the many requests that SSCT has received from people asking us to extend the Village to Village shuttle service into Ultimo so that they can access the Broadway shopping centre and China Town.

As this was logistically difficult for the shuttle and because SSCT does not currently offer any HACC bus shopping or access services to these communities. SSCT will now provide a new door to door service with assistance on and off the vehicle.



The bus will run on a small loop which includes stops at China Town, the Fish Market, the Ian Thorpe Aquatic Centre and the Broadway shopping centre. The bus will be driven by Yue and assistance on and off the vehicle and help carrying shopping will be provided by Eric, the bus assistant.

This service will commence on Friday 1st May starting at 9:00AM and 14 new clients who live in Ultimo have already booked on the 9:00am run.

Because there is already much demand for this new service, we strongly recommend that you call as soon as possible to secure your seat. There may also be capacity for residents of Glebe to use this service as the bus will circle around the back of the Broadway shopping centre when we have dropped off the Ultimo clients.

Sadly, Yue will no longer be the driver for the Village to Village Shuttle bus service on Fridays. The new driver is called Robbie and you will meet him soon as Alan and Yue will be conducting the training over the next couple of weeks.
